A MESSAGE FROM YOUR MAYOR

Greetings from City Hall. Christmas is fun but isn't it great to get back to normal. The City had a good year in 2021, and 2022 should be a great one. All City Departments are operating smoothly and it appears the Recreation Department is finally emerging from the pandemic. Participation and enthusiasm are up and hopefully will past pre Covid enrollment over the next year.

The City will be receiving a \$6,000.00 safety grant from the State over the next couple of months. I have earmarked this money for the purchase of five (5) AED devices. These will be the newest and most easily used devices available. For those not familiar, an AED is a self-contained heart monitor that is attached to a heart attack victim that can shock a heart back into rhythm. Our new AED 's will not require any decision by the user to shock or not to shock. All City employees will be trained and certified in their use. The new machines will be placed at the Senior Center, Library, City Hall, Gym, Rec Complex, and the new Municipal Building.

The City is busy making preparations for any snow/ice events we might have this year. Our Police Department is well equipped with 4 wheel drive vehicles with chains and the Water and Street Departments are also 4 wheel drive with chains. Hopefully, it will never be so bad that the PD cannot get to you in an emergency. The City is also equipped to salt our main roads and streets to help those hard to melt area clear up. The City maintains an emergency residence check list of addresses to visit under these conditions to verify everything is ok. If you have signed up for this service in the past, you are still on the list. If this is a service you would like, contact the PD or City Staff to be added. You can also add neighbors or relatives in the Mount Zion area that you feel would benefit from these welfare checks. No one will go without heat, food, medical attention, or a sense of security.

To prevent issues with your trash pick up please remember the following items:

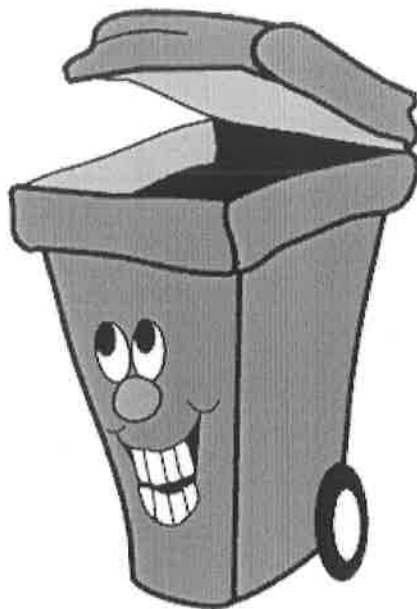
Please do not over fill your carts to the point that you can not close the lid or that you have items stack on top of the lid or around your cart.

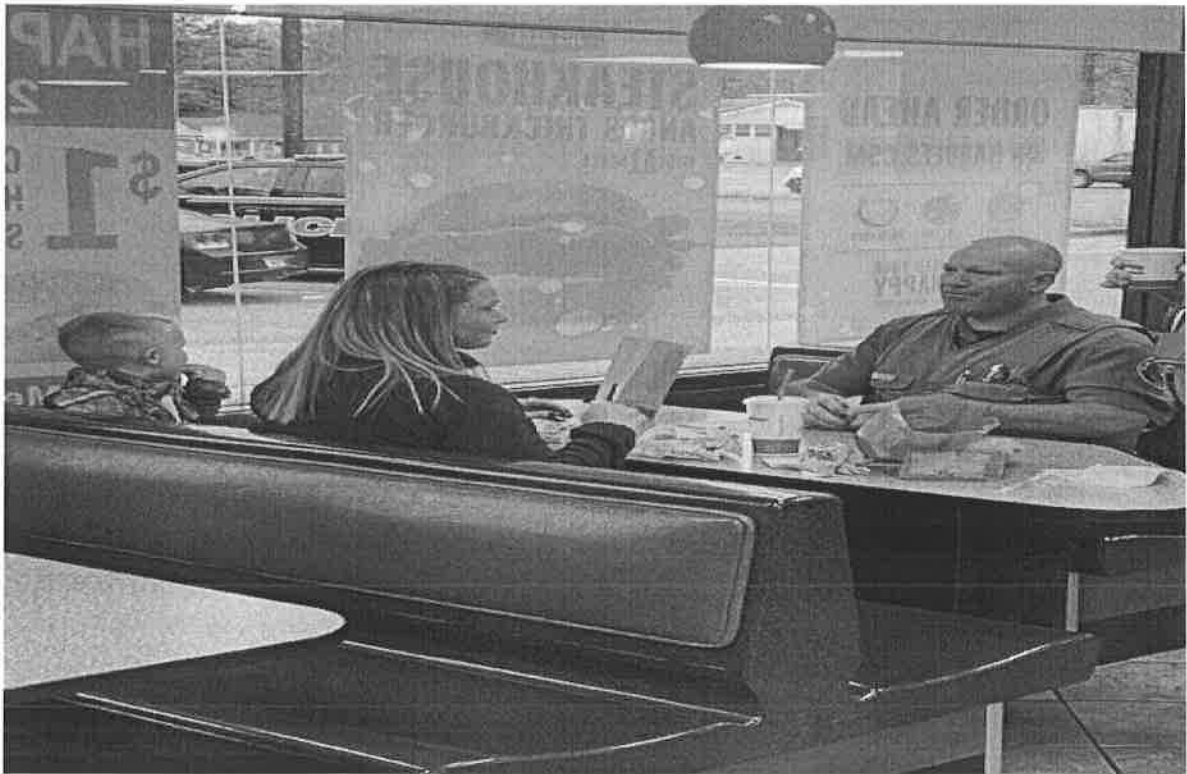
